## The Venue

Morley College

Morley College is a one-minute walk from Lambeth North underground station: turn left upon leaving the station, the venue is across the road on your right. The college is a 10-minute walk from Waterloo railway station.

The venue has wheelchair access. There is no onsite parking.

## Into Action: Creating the Fellowship We Crave

### Convention Saturday October 28<sup>th</sup>

The theme of the convention is 'Creating the Fellowship We Crave'. We aim to include speakers from every country where DAA groups have formed. Speakers will be invited to share their experience of Recovery, Unity and Service in DAA. Registration begins at 11 a.m., with the first speaker on stage at noon. We will break for lunch for an hour at 1:30 and then continue until around 8 p.m. There will be two refreshment breaks during the afternoon/evening session. A detailed programme will be available soon.

### Conference Sunday October 29<sup>th</sup>

The first World Conference aims to explore what the future might hold for DAA and to establish channels for effective international communication. We hope to bring together as many DAA members and groups as possible for the second day of the event. Doors open at 10 a.m. for a 10:30 start; we will finish at 4.30 p.m.

## Transport

Road: From the west, the venue is about 40 minutes to an hour from Heathrow or the M4/M25 junction. From the North, the venue is about 50 minutes to 80 minutes from the M1/M25 Junction. Please note that journey times may vary depending on traffic.

Coach: most Coaches into Central London stop at Victoria bus station. From here, take the underground: District line to Embankment, then the Bakerloo line to Lambeth North.

Trains: From Paddington, take the Bakerloo line direct to Lambeth North. From King's Cross, take the Piccadilly line to Piccadilly Circus, then the Bakerloo line to Lambeth North. From Euston, take the Victoria Line to Oxford Circus, then the Bakerloo Line to Lambeth North.

Air: Trains from Heathrow Airport go to Paddington; from here, take the Bakerloo line direct to Lambeth North. Underground from Heathrow: change at Piccadilly Circus for the Bakerloo line to Lambeth North. Trains from Gatwick Airport go to Victoria; from here, take the District line to Embankment, then the Bakerloo line to Lambeth North. Trains from Stanstead Airport go to Liverpool Street; from here, take the Central Line to Oxford Circus, then the Bakerloo Line to Lambeth North.

In London:

Oyster cards/travel cards: the cheapest tickets are daily 1&2 zone travel cards (for multiple trips), or buy an Oyster card and top up as you go. You will need to pay £5 deposit when you buy a new Oyster card, which is refundable if you return the card.

Buses: Waterloo is a major hub for buses travelling all over London.

Parking: There is some free street parking, use <http://en.parkopedia.co.uk/> and enter the destination Waterloo to find where it's available.

## Other stuff

Phoning the UK from abroad: +44 then the number without the first 0

Shopping and attractions: Waterloo is close to most of the good stuff in London, from West End shopping (open Sunday) to Tate Modern, Southbank, London Eye, and historic sites (Westminster Abbey, Buckingham Palace, Big Ben, Trafalgar Square etc. etc.)


